

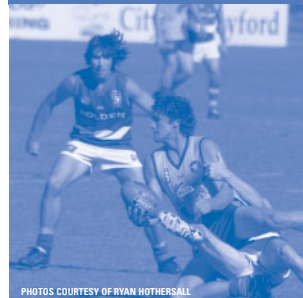

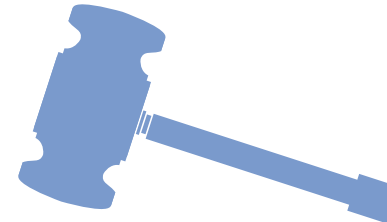

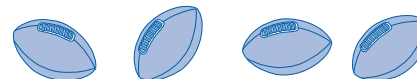
## Eagles v Central Districts
